- To carryout our commitment to Diversity Equity and Inclusion, and our Outreach Program with our Community.

About our Organization

- West Michigan Youth Ballet Brings students together from various dance schools across West
 Michigan for a day of rehearsal each week while dancers continue studying ballet at their home
 studio. Each season open auditions bring in students from as far as Traverse City, Kalamazoo,
 Muskegon and Mt. Pleasant. This enables all students the experience of creating a beautiful, fulllength performance.
- Tuition is intentionally kept low to ensure our main goal, that all interested youth have the opportunity to participate. With this initiative, WMYB tuition covers only about 30% of our total production costs.



About our organization, continued

- Partnerships with Grand Rapids Public Schools, Boys and Girls Club of Grand Rapids
 Commonwealth, Grandville Avenue Arts and Humanities and the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce
 to provide opportunities to attend WMYB performances have been developed.
- The Boys and Girls Club of Grand Rapids Commonwealth have had the opportunity to experience ballet instruction thru on-site workshops under a professional instructor. As this partnership enters its third year, sponsorship can be designated for the ongoing support of these wonderful students. Sponsorship assists with:
 - Weekly dance instruction for 15 students at the Boys & Girls Club
 - o Ballet slippers, pants, t-shirt and dance bag for 15 dancers.
 - A mini showcase with WMYB dancers and these students at the B&G Club

 - Live Stream of the performance to B&G Club participants.
- We continue to share our time and talent with Helen DeVos Children's Hospital through live stream/broadcast of the performances.

We are excited bring our holiday tradition of the Nutcracker to the stage on December 3rd and 4th at the Forest Hills Fine Arts Center.
