## The Story of Swan Lake

#### Act I

Long ago, in a forgotten kingdom, a beautiful princess was captured by the wicked sorcerer, Von Rothbart. As long as she remained under his spell, the Princess Odette was cursed to take the form of a swan and could only become human by the light of the moon.


Many years later, as Prince Siegfried celebrates his birthday, the Queen Mother reminds him that before he becomes king, he must end his care-free bachelor days and find a bride. As she presents him with a crossbow, he reluctantly accepts his duty and goes off alone to hunt.

At the lakeside, Siegfried spots a swan landing on the water and draws his bow, but as he aims, the swan magically transforms into the Princess Odette. She tells the prince of her curse; a fate that can only be broken if her true love vows eternal fidelity to her. For if the Sorcerer is killed, or her love's vow is broken, she is doomed to remain a swan for eternity. As dawn arrives, the Prince gives his promise that he will break the spell, but Von Rothbart swears to keep his power over her and conspires to bewitch the Prince.

#### Act II

At the Prince's castle, a royal ball is held so that he may choose a bride. The royal families from the neighboring kingdoms dance and present their Princesses. The Prince, remembering his vow to Odette, cannot choose. Suddenly, Von Rothbart enters in a human disguise to introduce his daughter, Odile. Odile seduces the Prince, tricking him into promising his love to her. The Prince realizes too late that he has been fooled and has broken his vow to Odette, condemning her to remain a swan for all time. He rushes to the lake to beg her forgiveness, but it is too late. Odette, in her sadness, tells Prince Siegfried that the only way the curse can be broken now, is in their next life. Prince Siegfried, vows to fulfill the promise he has broken and journey to the next life with her. Von Rothbart appears to stop them, but as he threatens to tear the two away from each other, they throw themselves into the lake, sealing their bond and vanquishing the power of Von Rothbart: their final act of love joining them for eternity.

#### **GUEST DANCERS**



JAKOB PRINGLE grew up in Carmel, Indiana, and studied at the Central Indiana Academy of Dance. He placed 2nd in the Semi-Finals of YAGP in 2012 and competed in the Finals in New York City where he performed in the Grand Défilé for the YAGP Closing Night Gala at Lincoln Center. Jakob has been honored to be a guest artist with North Star Ballet in Fairbanks, Alaska, New American Youth Ballet in Fort Wayne, Indiana, Queen City Ballet in Helena, Montana, and St. George Ballet Company in St. George, Utah for their productions of The

Nutcracker. He performed the role of Waltz Boy,set on him by Zippora Karz, in Utah Ballet's production of Serenade. He has performed with Ballet West in their productions of Aladdin, Cinderella, The Little Mermaid, Giselle and The Sleeping Beauty. In 2015, Jakob had the honor of performing the role of Death in Edward Stierle's Lacrymosa with Fort Wayne Ballet. This production was set on the company by Kim Sagami of the Arpino Joffrey Foundation. His training includes studying under Jeff Rogers and Peter Christie as a trainee with Ballet West in Salt Lake City, Utah, and numerous summer intensives across the US including Cincinnati Ballet, The Rock School of Dance, Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre School and Ballet West.



EDEN WEINSTEIN began his training at the Portland Ballet School in Portland, Maine. His ambition brought him to the Boston Ballet School when he was 12 years old and studied there for two years. He then transitioned to the intensive training of the Bossov Ballet for a year and returned to the Portland Ballet having greatly improved. Then, Eden studied at the Nutmeg Conservatory for the Arts for one year until he was accepted to the Joffrey Ballet of New York Apprentice Program under full scholarship. Eden has attended and been accepted to programs at the

Walnut Hill School, The ABT School, The Kirov Academy of Washington D.C., The San Francisco Ballet, and the School of American Ballet.

of the Arts where he trained under Melissa Hayden,
Duncan Noble, and Warren Conover. He later went to
Ballet Chicago Studio Company and was mentored by
Dan Duell and Patricia Blair. Stephen has attended
numerous summer courses including School of American
Ballet, Houston Ballet, and Hartford Ballet. Stephen has
had the opportunity to work with esteemed
choreographers and teachers such as Kirk Peterson, Val
Caniporoli, Suzanne Farrell, Daniel Duell, and Mario

Radacovsky during his 14 seasons performing as a principle dancer with Grand Rapids Ballet Company. Stephen has performed as a guest artist for New York Theater Ballet, Toledo Ballet, Tulsa Ballet, St. Louis Ballet, Ballet Chicago, Geiger Ballet, and Southhold Dance Theater. Alongside his performing career he taught classical technique classes at Grand Rapids Ballet School for 14 years and he has been teaching master classes thoughout the Midwest. He currently is teaching classical technique classes at Grand Valley State University and Ada Dance Academy. Stephen and his wife Jennifer have three daughters Julia, Elaina, Lucy and two sons Andrew and Nathan. This is Stephen's 3rd year leading the Artistic Direction for the West Michigan Youth Ballet.

#### BIOGRAPHIES



SAMANTHA SHELTON-Choreographer SAMANTHA SHELTON received her professional training from the Joffrey Ballet in New York and in Michigan with Rose Marie Floyd. She also studied in London with Anita Young (Royal Ballet) and at the Cecchetti International program in England. For the past eighteen years, she has been on the ballet faculty for American Ballet Theatre Summer Intensive, currently directed by Kate Lydon, setting ABT repertoire and choreographing new ballets for the final performances. Currently, she is on faculty for the ABT Summer Intensives at the University of Texas,

Austin, under the direction of Wes Chapman, former ABT principal and also travels the country as an adjudicator for the ABT National Audition Tour, selecting dancers for training programs in New York, Texas, California and Alabama. Samantha has also taught at the ABT program at the University of Alabama, directed by Carla Stallings and the Detroit Opera House/Wayne State University, directed by Alaine Haubert. She has choreographed and taught for the professional ballet programs at the Walnut Hill School in Boston, directed by former ABT principal, Michael Owen, Ballet Tennessee, Missouri Contemporary Ballet, and Interlochen Arts Academy. She has performed extensively in both classical and contemporary ballets, including the Grand Pas from Nutcracker, Sleeping Beauty, Don Quixote, also principal roles in Giselle and Raymonda. In her guest artist performances, she has partnered with Craig Salstein (of ABT), Arch Higgins (New York City Ballet) and Christopher Stowell (San Francisco Ballet) among many others. Samantha holds an M.F.A in Dance from the University of Michigan, where she was awarded a Rackham Thesis grant, and a B.A. in Political Science also from the University of Michigan. She has also done graduate work at New York University in Performing Arts Administration with internships in development, PR and marketing at Carnegie Hall and the Orchestra of St. Luke's. For six years, she served on the University of Michigan's School of Music, Theatre & Dance Alumni Society Board of Governors and in May 2012 spent three weeks in Taiwan, teaching and presenting a piece of choreography for Tainan University. She is certified through the American Ballet Theatre National Curriculum Training Program and in August of 2014, co-taught the ABT NTC with Harriet Clark, at the Detroit Opera House. Currently, she is a Professor of Ballet at Grand Valley State University in Grand Rapids, Ml.

#### **BIOGRAPHIES**



LAURA SCHWENK-BERMAN is an Artistic Associate of RPM Productions in Chicago and has been performing, teaching, choreographing, staging and rehearsing works for over 40 years. She began her performing career dancing principal roles with the Garden State Ballet, the Chicago Ballet, the Boston Repertory Ballet, and for seven years with the Pacific Northwest Ballet in Seattle. While with Pacific Northwest Ballet, Ms. Berman performed as a soloist with Gelsey Kirkland in Swan Lake and with Mikhail Baryshnikov as part of the Pacific Northwest

Ballet/Baryshnikov tour. She danced in the film: "Nutcracker: The Motion Picture" directed by Carol Ballard, designed by Maurice Sendak. She has toured extensively throughout the United States, Europe and Asia as a guest artist.

Ms. Berman served as the Ballet Mistress (1992–97), Interim Artistic Director (1997-98) and Associate Artistic Director of the Grand Rapids Ballet Company (1998-2010). During that time she conducted two capital campaigns to build beautiful new studios, offices and rehearsal space, as well as a state-of-the-art LEED certified 300-seat theatre of the company's own. She also served as Director of the School of the Grand Rapids Ballet Company from 1998 –2010, establishing the school's curriculum, syllabus, faculty, staff and performances, placing students in major ballet companies around the world including New York City Ballet, San Francisco Ballet and Royal Danish Ballet.

Ms. Berman has choreographed works for Momenta! Performing Arts Company, Chicago Repertory Dance Ensemble, Northwestern University Dance Ensemble, the Cecchetti Council of America, the Evanston Dance Ensemble, the Grand Rapids Ballet Junior and Senior Companies and the West Michigan Youth Ballet. In addition, she regularly stages full-length classical ballets and is a private instructor and coach.

Ms. Berman has taught dance at a wide array of institutions including the University of Washington, Northwestern University, Columbia College, Hope College, Loretta Heights College, Hubbard Street Dance Company, Chicago Academy for the Performing Arts, Oak Park Academy of Movement and Music, the Cecchetti Council of America, Evanston Dance Center, the Grand Rapids Ballet Company, and Ada Dance Academy.

Ms. Berman has a Bachelor of Science degree from Skidmore College and a Masters degree in Theatre from Northwestern University where she graduated with honors.

MARLENE KENNEWAY-Chair and Co-Founder of the non-profit West Michigan Youth Ballet Company Marlene has studied with the Boston Ballet and Rosella Hightower in Cannes, France. She has taught at Cullman College, Erie Civic Ballet, Decatur Civic Ballet in Alabama, and is the owner and founder of Ada Dance Academy in Ada, Michigan. Mrs. Kenneway has served on the Steering Committee for the American Ballet Theatre summer seminar, and is the past advisor and board member for the Grand Rapids Ballet. She is the past President of the Ada Council for the Arts and a member of the Mary Free

Bed Guild. 
