Alexey Kulpin is a graduate of the Institute of Culture and Art in St. Petersburg, Russia. He holds both bachelor's and master's degrees in ballet pedagogy and choreography. In 1998, he was the Grand Prix winner at the Muse of St. Petersburg Ballet Competition. As a professional dancer, Mr. Kulpin has performed soloist and principal roles in both classical and contemporary ballets in Russia, Israel, and the United States. He danced professionally with St. Petersburg State Opera Ballet, St. Petersburg State Male Theatre by Mihailovsky, Ballet Israel, City Ballet of San Diego, Grand Rapids Ballet, Charleston Ballet Theater, Stars of St. Petersburg Municipal Theater of Music and Dance, and

Krasnoyarsk Dance Ensemble. His roles included Basilio in Don Quixote; James in La Sylphide; Prince Ivan in Firebird; Spirit of the Rose in Le Spectre de la Rose; Swan Lake Pas de Trois; and the male leads in Tarentella and Maurice Bejart's Trik Trak.

SUMMER MASTER CLASS

Mr. Kulpin specializes in teaching classical ballet, male and female variations, and character dance. His teaching career includes the Ballet Israel School, City Ballet of San Diego, Grand Rapids Ballet, and Charleston Ballet Company, where he taught company classes and served as director of the Charleston Ballet Young Artists Group. Most recently, he served as principal ballet teacher for Northern California Dance Conservatory. He has staged classical variations and choreographed solos for performance and ballet competitions, including Youth America Grand Prix. Mr. Kulpin joined The HARID Conservatory's faculty in August, 2016. He remains active as a quest teacher and a ballet-competition iudge.

As a principal dancer, he has collaborated with renowned choreographers and ballet masters from around the globe, including Francia Russell, Daniel Duell, Paul Boos, Mario Radacovsky, Kirk Peterson, Wes Chapman, Gordon Peirce Schmidt, Charthel Arthur Estner, and Olivier Wevers, among others. His repertoire spans classical and neo-classical works, with notable lead performances in

George Balanchine's iconic ballets such as *Apollo, Who Cares, Four Temperaments, Serenade, The Nutcracker, Valse Fantaisie, Rubies, Stars and Stripes, and Concerto Barocco* and Gerald Arpino's *Light Rain.* Stephen's talent has also graced numerous ballet companies as a guest artist, including New York Theater Ballet, Tulsa Ballet, St. Louis Ballet, Ballet Chicago, Geiger Ballet, Southold Dance Theater, and Ohio Theatre Ballet. In addition to his performing career, Stephen has dedicated over 25 years to teaching ballet. He has taught advanced and master classes at institutions like Grand Valley State University, Grand Rapids Ballet School, and currently for Ada Dance Academy, Ballet Chicago, and Deos Contemporary Company. Since 2015, Stephen has served as the Artistic Director of West Michigan Youth Ballet, guiding hundreds of young dancers and nurturing their passion for dance through productions like *Coppélia, Sleeping Beauty, Cinderella, The Nutcracker, Swan Lake,* and *The Wizard of Oz.* Beyond his artistic endeavors, Stephen cherishes his role as a family man. He and his wife, Jennifer, along with their five children–Julia, Andrew, Elaina, Nathan, and Lucy–are the heart of his life and inspiration.

WMYB BIOGRAPHIES



LAURA SCHWENK-BERMAN - CHOREOGRAPHER

Laura Schwenk-Berman has been performing, teaching, choreographing, and staging works for over 45 years. She began her professional career dancing principal roles for the Garden State Ballet and subsequently danced with Chicago Ballet, Boston Ballet, and for seven years with the Pacific Northwest Ballet. There she performed as a soloist with Gelsey Kirkland and Mikhail Baryshnikov and danced in *Nutcracker: The Motion Picture.* She has toured as a guest artist throughout the United States, Europe, and Asia. Ms.

Berman served as the Ballet Mistress, Interim Artistic Director, Associate Artistic Director, and Director of the School of the Grand Rapids Ballet Company from 1992-2010. She conducted two capital campaigns for GRB, one to renovate the old North Star Bus Terminal into four beautiful studios and administrative offices; the second, to build the company's Peter Martin Wege Theatre and costume shop. At that time, GRB received the Michigan Governor's Arts Award for excellence and toured the Midwest and Canada, reaching an audience of over 500,000. As Director of the School of the Grand Rapids Ballet Company, she established the school's curriculum, syllabus, faculty, and performances, while placing students in ballet companies around the world. Ms. Berman has a Masters Degree in Theatre from Northwestern University where she graduated with honors. Currently she works as a freelance artist, choreographing original works and staging full-length ballets, and as a guest master instructor and private coach. She also serves on the Advisory Board of WMYB.



HEATHER CASSADY - COSTUME DESIGNER, COSTUMER

Heather graduated from Michigan State University with a BA in Clothing and Textile Design with an emphasis in Fashion Design. She then began an 11-year career as a Costumer with the Walt Disney Company. She was the Costumer for a variety of parades and stage shows in all four of the Walt Disney World Parks and many of their resort properties. Some of her shows included the *Remember the Magic* Parade, *SpectroMagic, Around the World with Mickey and Minnie.*

THE STORY OF SLEEPING BEAUTY

ACT I Once upon a time, a beautiful princess was born. Her parents named her Aurora and invited all the fairies of the land to her christening, except the evil fairy Carabosse. To everyone's horror, Carabosse arrives at the ceremony anyway. Angry that she was not invited, Carabosse places an evil curse on baby Aurora: when she is sixteen years old, she will prick her finger and die. Fortunately, the good and wise Lilac Fairy is also at the christening. Although she cannot remove the curse completely, she is powerful enough to change it! She declares that when the princess pricks her finger, she will not die, but instead fall asleep for one hundred years. The Lilac Fairy adds that a handsome Prince can awaken Aurora with a kiss.

The years passed peacefully and on Aurora's sixteenth birthday, the King and Queen throw Aurora a wonderful party. Princes travel from afar to join the celebration and each Prince at the party presents her with a rose in a dance called the Rose Adagio. Men and women of the court and villagers attend the celebration.

Delighted, Aurora shows her gratitude by dancing for the guests. But then, the powerful Carabosse stops time at the birthday party and her Minions entice Aurora to the palace tower. Mesmerized by Carabosse's spinning wheel, Aurora touches the spindle and becomes dizzy as the Lilac Fairy's spell begins to take effect, instead of Carabosse's curse. Soon Aurora is in a deep sleep.

ACT II *One hundred years later:* The handsome Prince Desire from a nearby kingdom is looking for game with his hunting party. While away from his party, he meets many friendly woodland creatures and curious characters. As Prince Desire takes an afternoon nap, the Lilac Fairy visits him in a dream. She shows him where his true love sleeps. As the Prince awakens, he is confronted by the evil Carabosse and her Minions. He must defeat them all to save Aurora. Once Aurora is kissed by the Prince, the spell is broken. The story concludes with a celebration of their royal wedding, after which they lived happily ever after.

GUEST PERFORMERS



DARRELL HAGGARD is originally from Oakhurst, California, where he found his love for dance at Velocity Dance Studio at the age of 9. At age 17, he began training on scholarship at the Los Angeles Ballet Academy with Ms. Andrea Paris. Wolfgang was eventually invited to guest dance with Children's Ballet Theater, which led to him to join their company for their 2018-2019 season. He has also attended summer intensives at Grand Rapids Ballet, Northeast Academy of Dance, Cincinnati Ballet, and New York Dance Project. At Grand Valley State University, Wolfgang studied ballet and modern dance technique along with dance

history, dance costuming, dance on camera, choreography, urban dance, and dance pedagogy. While at GVSU, Wolfgang continued to perform as a guest dancer with various companies, including HIS Dance, Greater Lansing Ballet Company, and WMYB. In 2023, he graduated with a B.A. in Dance. Currently, Wolfgang is dancing with CPR Dance: Inhale Movement for their sophomore season, as well as guest dancing with various groups around Michigan.



XANDER GOLUSKA is a Lansing-based dancer with over a decade of performance experience. He has been featured in performances with various groups, including the Children's Ballet Theatre and West Michigan Youth Ballet. He primarily performs with the Greater Lansing Ballet Company.
